#### Spiritual

- Recognising achievements in Computing and the possibilities for the future
- Providing opportunities for pupils to explore their creativity and imagination when creating digital artefacts
- Reflecting on those situations where computers perform better than people
- Promoting self esteem through opportunities to present their work to others

#### Moral

- Understanding the advantages and limitations of technology
- Exploring issues surrounding misuse of technology, trust, copyright and plagiarism
- Exploring the effects of social networking and consequences of cyber bullying
- Understanding that in society there are shared and agreed values

#### Social

- Highlighting ways to stay safe when using online services and social media
- Promoting good etiquette habits when using digital technologies and social media - pupils are to care for and respect people and property
- Discussing the impact of Computing on the ways people communicate and helping pupils to express themselves clearly
- Encouraging collaborative learning within lessons through paired activities

#### Cultural

- Developing a sense of awe and wonder at human ingenuity
- Empowering pupils to apply their computing skills and knowledge to the wider curriculum
- Awareness that Computing involves the breaking through of linguistic and cultural barriers - we can communicate with people from all around the world
