

Lilleshall Primary School Wave System

The Four Waves of Provision

Wave 1 – Quality First Teaching. The majority of children achieve well through high quality classroom teaching. Quality First Teaching provides high quality work as part of a broad and rich curriculum that engages children in a range of activities and experiences to develop knowledge, skills and understanding.

Wave 2 – Small group and one to one interventions. Some children require additional support to achieve well. This will be provided through-time limited intervention programmes delivered by a member of the school's classroom-based support team that will advance children's progress and help them achieve in line with their peers.

School will complete a Wave 2 intervention sheet for the children in their class receiving this support which will follow the assess, plan, do, review graduated response. This will be reviewed termly.

Wave 3 – Intensive support. This is for those children who require the personalised approach of a programme that is tailored to their specific, sometimes more complex difficulties. This will involve the support of identified outside agencies to advise on appropriate intervention. School will complete an Individual Learning Plan (ILP) where children and parents will have a chance to contribute to the process. This will be reviewed termly and you will be invited to be a part of this process each time.

Wave 4 – Children who receive funding from the Inclusive Support Forum (ISF) or have an Educational Health Care Plan (EHCP) will be in Wave 4 and they will have a Local Authority review yearly where parents and children will be involved in the process of applying or reviewing. They will also have an ILP in school, reviewed termly.

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
