Pupil Discussions: 11:00-11:20

- Pupils are able to identify how prior learning helps with new learning and are able to give examples e.g. Y4 recall their Y3 London mapwork. Y6 can describe how earlier work on South America helps them to gain a greater understanding of South America in more recent studies.
- What would you do if you were unsure or stuck in a lesson? Ask someone on table, look back in book, ask more people, see 3 before me, read question again, use classroom resources, go to next question, then go back to it, finally – ask the teacher. Pupils eventually gave a variety of answers, but responses didn't come readily.
- How do you think that learning in this subject / topic/area will be of use to you in the future? Pupils describe help with map reading when older, qualifications, career (teacher) and the transfer of learning skills,
- Pupils know that they are getting better at geography: they can add things onto a mind map which shows that their knowledge is growing.
