- We discussed the role of a school council member and what qualities it might be important for a school council member to have.
- Discussed how some suggestion boxes had become tatty so we will create a space on the display area to collect and place suggestion slips and we will let school know this at next groups assembly.
- Shared news of project and trip to find out more about 'Telford Community Grocery' a charity that helps support families struggling with food costs. We discussed how this will be introduced to school in an assembly and then we will visit the charity as a school council to find out more and think of ideas to support them.
- Mrs Savill came to share the role of school council in terms of looking after the health and well being of our school.
- We then shared some initial ideas that school council might want to look at.
 - The need for equipment to be put away carefully at breaktimes (check with sports leaders?)
 - Shed monitors are struggling to put things away as people are throwing equipment in or getting in the way (talk to staff on playground duty)
 - Colour monsters- school council members will keep a look out for children who have placed pegs and ask if they can help
 - To check all classes have a worry monster that children can write worries down and put into.
