To begin today's meeting, we reflected on this year's Internet Safety Week and the messages that came out of it. We then began thinking of competition ideas for next year's Internet Safety Week. Here's what we came up with...

- Design your own t-shirt
- Code breaker for pupils and a morse code breaker for teachers
- Design a poster/sign
- Who's the hacker? 'Guess who' style - images of individuals and pupils have to decide who the hacker is.
- Timed quiz - 60 seconds to answer as many online safety questions as possible
- Write your own story (must include a negative online situation and how to overcome it)
- E-Safety Bingo - to take place in a school assembly. E-Safety team ask a question and if you have the answer on your bingo card, you cross it off.
- Hangman - online safety style
- Is the password good or not?

Our next task was completing a school survey of any online safety reminders around school. This allowed us to see if any classrooms or areas were missing these.

To finish the session, we began looking at age ratings of apps. Lots of us weren't aware that these existed and have access to lots of apps that are not age-appropriate. This will lead us into our next session where we will create a quiz to find out about how apps are being used within school and whether our peers are playing age-appropriate games.
