Purpose of the meeting: Internet Safety Week 2024 (6.2.24)

Minutes

- Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 chose E-safety activities for their class.
- The team thought about ideas for competitions, quizzes, raising the profile of Internet Safety Week and posters.
- We had a discussion about what the theme for this year and watched the videos for the assemblies for Internet Safety Day on Tuesday 6th February.
- This year's theme is: 'Inspiring Change? Making a difference, managing influence and navigating change online.' We thought about how we can promote this in our classes next week and made a mind map of ideas and thoughts.

These were some of the ideas we thought about:

Ideas for in school next week/morning activities:

- To make posters to show what e-safety is about/raise profile of week.
- Make an e-safety slide to send to parents/put something on website
- Digital footprint—influenced by every choice made online. What's on your digital footprint?
- Technology Debates cars. E.g. Is a self-driving car a good idea? (morning activity - could write their opinion on a speech bubble)
- Unscramble game with words.
- Messages that influencers share with people. Use posters to express how people are influenced. (No outsiders—online)
- Technology in jobs quiz/activity.
- Quiz about how to stay safe online.
- What are changes in games?

- Drawing competition/e-safety card game differences and changes

Ideas to send home:

- What is the most interesting piece of technology you can find out about that is weird and wonderful or would bring change to the technology world?
- AI technology—to send home, technology they grew up with, useful technology in jobs. What tech do you have in home what do you use it for?
- Design our own piece of technology—future.

Ideas for after Internet Safety Week:

- T shirts—summer term? Computing open evening.
- Make an inspiring video of our own— website/share with classes.

Activities for morning/computing lessons:

Year 1: Activity 1 - Tech through time as a whole class (Ordering pictures oldest to newest), Activity 2 - Story followed by discussion on the carpet, Activity 3 - Feelings caused by using technology - draw/print out pictures of technology and link to feelings.

Year 2 - Activity 1 - Tech through time, Activity 2 - Story and whole-class discussion, Activity 3 - Whole class - change what is it?

Year 3 - Activity 1 - tech through time in pairs, Activity 2 act out the story and discuss, Activity 3 in pairs - what has changed, whole-class discussion.

Year 4 - Activity 1 - Tech through time (individual strips), activity 3 (how does the internet influence us?) AI introduction about what it is, activity 5 - whole class/morning activity.

Year 5 - Tech through time (individual strips), activity 2 pick the persuasion as a whole class, activity 3 (how does the internet influence us?), Activity 5 - influencer - morning activity. Discuss AI in the future and YouTube in future.

Year 6- activity 1 (tech through time), activity 2 in groups, activity 4 (AI), Activity 5 yes in pairs.
