 - Set up folders for meetings to save work into.
 - Have a stall at the Christmas fayre.
 - Create a larger presence around school - 'Did you know?' facts and E-safety board on the blue door in the hall (to include: tips for staying safe online, names/photos, the E-safety rules, promote Live Chat Wednesdays, digital footprint, display the logo)
 - E-safety awards for children contributing positively in E-Safety lessons or making good choice.
 - The team shared what their online life looks like including games that they like to play and platforms that they use regularly (see additional sheet).
 - Live Chat Wednesdays - re-establish in addition to an online form which children can choose to fill in if they do not feel comfortable discussing their worry in person.
 - Worry Monster, children could share e-safety concerns on a coloured post-it note which can be given to Mrs Phillips.

- Raise concerns about age-appropriate games and share age-appropriate games with teachers who can address their whole class about any concerns and promote new games.
- Work on ways to support our peers with navigating the online world.
