Think about what happens when you meet a stranger. Would you tell them everything about you? Should you even talk to them? The same rules apply when online. Think carefully about what you share.

Speak out, stay safe!

If you are unsure about something online, you can ask a member of our committee or a trusted adult over the age of eighteen.

Here is a short video to help you to stay safe. We chose this video because we know lots of you like to play games and pop-ups can appear out of nowhere.
